Conquering Everest Part 2 I should say that despite the tragic and to the 1922 expedition and some other expeditions which followed the 1922 one the British didn't give up trying to conquer Everest.</p> <p>In 1953 the British organized a new expedition. They trained in the Himalayas with improved oxygen equipment and planned the attack on the Summit with great care. 35 Sherpas helped the climbers in the training camp and finally six were selected out of them to climb to the top with the climbing teams.</p> <p>At the end of April, the climbers left their training camp to start their long journey to the top. There main groups of climbers with Sherpas set up several camps on the way with supplies and equipment. Each man wore windproof suit, three pairs of gloves and special waterproof boots. They slept in small tents in sleeping bags and cooked their meals on gas stoves. A typical Everest dinner was a mug of soup, tin steak and a fruit cake with tea, coffee or lemon juice. All in all, nine camps were set up. Camp 9 was built at a height of 8500 meters. The Summit was very close in about 350 meters from the camp. Two pairs of climbers were chosen for the final attack on the Summit from camp 9. The first attempt was made by Tom Bourdillon and Charles Evans. On May 26th they almost reached the summit but had to turn back because of some trouble with the oxygen apparatus.</p> <p>The second pair was Edmund Hillary and Tenzing Norgay. Hillary was a 33-year-old beekeeper from New Zealand and Tenzing was a Sherpa, six years older than Hillary and he had already climbed Everest six times with different climbing teams. Hillary's first attempt to climb the mountain was in 1951. The two men became good friends. Hillary and Tenzing arrived at the camp at night on May 28th and spent a night in their tents freezing from cold. At 6.30 on May 29th after breakfast of sardines, some biscuit and lemon juice they set off. It took them five hours to reach the Summit. For fifteen minutes Hillary and Tenzing were standing on top of the World. While Hillary was taking pictures, Tenzing left chocolate and some biscuit on the top to please the gods. Then they returned and were met by their support team. The radio message was sent that Everest had been finally conquered. Well, Everest has now been climbed several times but there are still a lot of new climbers who want to test themselves on the highest mountain of the world.
